

# Supermodel Bookmark

The thread I was using spoke to me, it said "I want to be tall and thin, glamorous and sexy, I want to be a supermodel!" Far be it from me to ever deny a thread its desires. The Supermodel bookmark here is tatted in size 40 Vineyard at Dusk by Dr. Von Threadmore (<http://krystledawnetats.blogspot.com/>). The pattern as is creates a rather short body if you want a longer bookmark you can repeat the section in red.

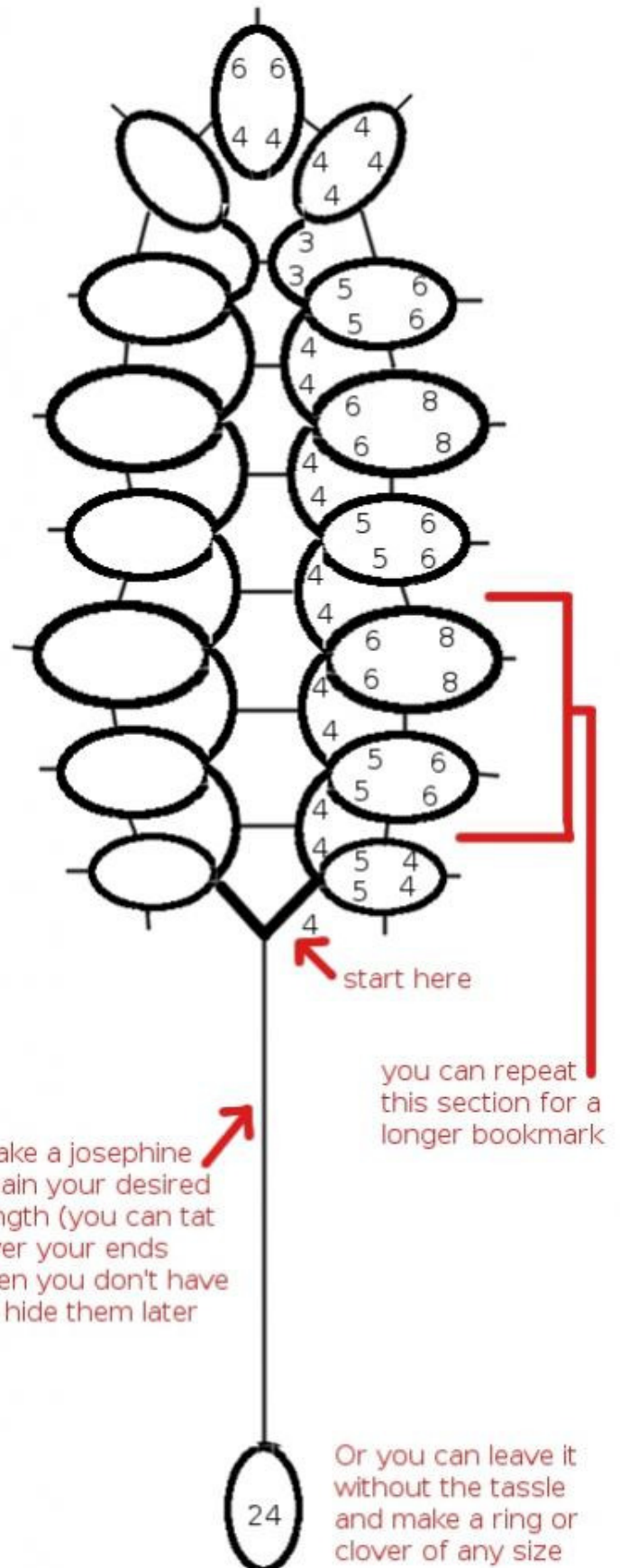
C 3-3  
 (next three rings create a clover) R 4+4-4-4  
 R 4+6-6-4  
 R 4+4-4-4  
 (all chains connect to the chain across

from it)

C 3+3  
 R 5+6-6-5  
 C 4+4  
 R 6+8-8-6  
 C 4+4  
 R 5+6-6-5  
 C 4+4  
 R 6+8-8-6  
 C 4+4  
 R 5+6-6-5  
 C 4+4  
 R 5+4-4-5  
 C 4

Tie ends together with those you from your first chain and make a Josephine chain for as long you like (you can tat over those threads from the beginning so you don't have to hide them any more)  
 R 24

Hide ends and add a tassel. If you don't want a tassel you can alternatively make a ring of any size or even make a clover
